

Campus Ministry Mission Trip

"Last year our youth ministry embarked on a transformative


mission trip to Uganda, where we provided crucial medical services to refugees. Our dedicated team worked tirelessly to deliver care and support to those in need, making a significant impact on their lives.

This is a brief introduction as to what our youth ministries do. We bring students from America and students from Africa together in medical and spiritual cross-cultural service for Christ to the refugees in the camps of Northern Uganda.

Our Values are fostering a living connection to Christ through service, and a clear self-sacrificial demonstration of the Gospel and proclamation of the Cross.

Each year, between 20 and 30 students (American and African) will share the word of God by providing medical clinic care and gospel outreach programs in the camps.

The vision for the mission compound being built will provide housing for African and American college students who will be part of yearly or biyearly mission events. (20 days in December/January)



We are grateful for each opportunity to take Dakota students and others to minister



in the Refugee Camps in Uganda every other Winter. Thanks to the very generous churches and individuals in the Dakota Conference, who support making these cross-cultural experiences a reality and these mission projects possible.

Most individuals we serve are refugees with enormous medical needs. A mobile

Medical Clinic and Pharmacy as you see in this picture is set up for two weeks providing free services and medication.

Students and doctors at the Clinic treat a variety of illnesses and provide free Medication, and Mental Health Counseling, and of course Prayer and Bible Study.

Last mission we completed construction of the foundation and walls of the medical building, and the roof and windows were completed soon afterward. This location will be the staging area and office for the Adventist Mercy Initiative work. Medical Missionary work will be the focus each student trip.

On the 2023/24 mission we rented an unused UN School building for our clinic and children's programs. The location was deep in the refugee camps in Northern

Uganda on the Sudanese border.

Our work was medical, children's ministry and mission construction. Here you see the pharmacy we opened for 11 days with the doctors and nursing students from the US and Uganda treating the patients. The teams served 707 people and gave away 3099 USD of medications.

Refugee patients have walked miles to be seen by the medical team. These individuals bring all their children with them.





Hundreds of children attend the children's Bible school we operate with the clinic. 477 children came to our children's ministries programs throughout the week below.
