Contrary to tradition, the law in the Bible is the entire Torah, not just the Ten Commandments (Matthew 7:12; 22:40, Luke 16:16, Acts 13:15, Romans 3:21). In the New Testament, "the Law and the Prophets" is interchangeable with "Moses and the prophets" (Luke 16:29, 16:31; 24:27, 44). To properly understand the Old and New Testaments, we must approach the Bible with the Law defined as the Torah, beyond the Ten Commandments. This perspective transforms our understanding of the entire Bible.

The Law, or Torah, is God's most powerful introduction to humanity. It reveals God's character and identity. This revelation reshapes our interpretation of the Historical books, not as a collection of stories about people, but as a single STORY of God's faithfulness despite human failures. The Wisdom books become the most *relatable* human expressions of faith even in despair, and the Prophets become the most transparent expressions of God's love and commitment to His people, despite their demise(Babylon). This paradigm shift forever transforms our understanding of Jesus. Understanding the true meaning and purpose of the Law changes everything.
